This two-day training course (August 29 & September 30) is intended for Assistant, Associate and Full professors who are interested in applying for Horizon Europe (HE) Pillar 2 collaborative grants. Participants are encouraged to come with an identified call they would like to apply for. If a participant does not have an (open or closed) call that fits their research, they will be grouped with another participant. Registered participants must take part in both days.

2 September 2024: LU Workshop: How to write a Data Management Plan

Planning how to deal with your data during and after your research project is considered to be essential nowadays. Leiden University has adopted a regulation that states that researchers have to write a data management plan before the start of each research project. Funders like NWO and ERC require you to add a data management paragraph in your proposal.

NWO-Talent programme Vici 2024 (open for all disciplines)

NWO Rubicon 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Rubicon aims to encourage talented researchers who recently received their PhD to spend some time at research institutes outside of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to further their scientific career.

Deadline: 3 September 2024

NWA Innovative projects within routes (open for all disciplines)

Within this call for proposals, applicants selected by route management can apply for funding for up to 3 innovative projects within each NWA route. These projects focus on an innovative idea, promotion of utilization of existing knowledge or synthesis of existing knowledge.

Deadline: 12 September 2024

NWA Social dynamics in the energy transition. From practice to theory (for several disciplines)

This thematic NWA programme focuses on research into the behaviour of groups of people and the energy transition. The energy transition is urgent and developments in this field are in full swing. There is a need for practical, scientific tools that support policy development based on knowledge on social dynamics and help policymakers anticipate and respond to unpredictable or surprising behaviours.

Deadline for pre-registration: 24 September 2024

Deadline full application: 22 April 2025

KIC: Together for a better life with inherited heart disease: Innovations for early detection, risk prediction and therapy (open for several disciplines)

Hereditary heart diseases lead to severe symptoms at an early age and therefore have a major impact on patients and their surroundings. The NWO - Heart Foundation partnership funds inter- and transdisciplinary research into early detection, risk prediction and therapy in order to increase the number of life years with a good quality of life. The research also explicitly covers the social aspects involved.

Deadline (sub-)proposals: 24 September 2024.

NWA Sexually transgressive behaviour and sexual violence (open for several disciplines)

This NWA programme aims to bundle existing knowledge and develop new knowledge about what effectively contributes to preventing (online and offline) sexually transgressive behaviour and sexual violence as much as possible. This knowledge is used to encourage societal change and construct an integrated approach with effective intervention and prevention strategies.

Deadline: 27 January 2025 (Letter of Intent deadline: 23 September 2024)

NWO Faculty of Impact (Psychology, CADS, CWTS)

Faculty of Impact offers researchers from the alpha, beta, and gamma sciences an intensive, two-year programme where they learn how to make an impact with their research and start their own business. Themes of call round 2024: 'Agriculture, water and food', 'circular economy', 'energy transition', 'health and care', and 'security'.

Deadline: 1 October 2024

NWA-ORC Research along Routes by Consortia (open for all disciplines)

The aim of the NWA-ORC 2024 call for proposals is to encourage research that is set up and carried out by interdisciplinary consortia that include representatives from the full breadth of the knowledge chain as well as relevant societal (public and/or private) partners, including citizens. The research will address so called wicked problems, focused on themes that are proposed by NWA-route networks and based on one or more of the 140 cluster questions.

Deadline: 1 October 2024

Faculty of Impact 24/25 – Agriculture, water and food and Circular Economy (open to all disciplines)

The Faculty of Impact program is aimed at researchers who want to achieve impact with their research and are interested in developing entrepreneurial skills to set up their own business. These researchers can now submit a grant application to become a fellow at the Faculty of Impact. A maximum of €185,000 is available per application. The duration of this program is two years.
Deadline: 1 October 2024

ADM-LAB: Livings Labs for Adaptive Delta Management in Bangladesh (CADS, Political Science, Psychology, CWTS)

The Netherlands and Bangladesh, as densely populated delta countries, are susceptible to the effects of climate change. Effective natural resource management is crucial for inclusive development, prosperity, food security, and climate-resilient infrastructure.
Deadline: 1 October 2024

NGF AiNed XS Europe 24-3 (open for all disciplines)

The NGF AiNed XS Europe grants are intended to support promising ideas and to facilitate innovative and more speculative initiatives that focus on the challenges outlined in the national AI research agenda AIREA-NL and are designed in collaboration with at least one European collaborative partner organization. The proposed research is ground-breaking and involves a real risk of failure.
Deadlines: 8 October 2024

NWA Loneliness (open to several disciplines)

The Dutch Research Agenda thematic programme "NWA Loneliness" aims to contribute to a better understanding of the causes and nature of loneliness, contribute to the understanding of effective interventions to reduce loneliness, and contribute to the understanding of the possible taboo of loneliness in society.
Deadline: 10 October 2024, 12 November 2024

SSH Open Competition XS 2024 – Round 2 (open for all disciplines)

The SSH Open Competition XS Call for proposals is specifically intended to encourage curiosity-driven and innovative research that involves the relatively rapid exploration of a promising idea.
Deadline Round 3: 15 October 2024

KIC: breaking through barriers for an inclusive living environment (open for several disciplines)

People with a disability have a right to an accessible environment. As a society, we can use innovative solutions to ensure that it is possible to live a good life with a disability. Innovative solutions – digital, physical or social – contribute to the possibility of participating in society in a way that suits someone with a disability.

"The Water-Food nexus in rainfed agri-food systems in Sub-Saharan Africa: socio-economics and governance" (anthropology; political science)

This call for proposals builds on the attention for the water-food nexus generated during the UN Water Conference of 2023, and on the work of the Global Commission on the Economics of Water. It focusses on better understanding the governance and socio-economics of rainfed agri-food systems, such that scaling of practices that make these systems resilient to changes in the water cycle can take place.
Deadline: 15 October 2024

Cooperation Taiwan (NSTC) Joint Seminars (open for all disciplines)

NWO has a cooperation agreement with the National Science and Technology Council of Taiwan (NSTC). The aim of the cooperation programme is to promote contacts between Dutch and Taiwanese researchers. The programme offers the opportunity to organise a joint seminar in the Netherlands or Taiwan.
Deadline: 15 October 2024

Cooperation Taiwan (NSTC) Research Visits (open for all disciplines)

NWO has a cooperation agreement with the National Science and Technology Council of Taiwan (NSTC). The aim of the cooperation programme is to promote contacts between Dutch and Taiwanese researchers. The programme offers the opportunity for a Dutch researcher to visit Taiwan and a Taiwanese researcher to visit the Netherlands.
Deadline: 15 October 2024

SSH Open Competition M 2024 (open for all disciplines)

The SSH Open Competition M funding instrument is open to research proposals with a question and/or problem definition within the social sciences and humanities. Within this field the instrument has no further thematic limitations. The instrument is aimed at excellent disciplinary, interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research. This certainly includes fundamental scientific research.

Deadline: 31 October 2024

NWO Merian Fund Cooperation Brazil – The Netherlands Health in Cities 2024 (open for all disciplines)

NWO, through the Merian Fund, and the research council of the state of São Paulo (FAPESP) work together in the Cooperation Brazil (FAPESP) programme to stimulate Brazil-Dutch collaboration in research, by funding joint research by inter- and transdisciplinary teams of Dutch and Brazilian researchers and stakeholders.

Deadline 12 November 2024

“Blue economy: economic activities and healthy ecosystems in oceans” (open for several disciplines)

The joint research projects should focus on balancing oceans’ multiple uses for creating sustainable blue economies. Consortia of research institutes and practitioner organisations (both public and private) in the Netherlands and in Indonesia can apply for funding. NWO and the Indonesian Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology (KemendikbudRistek) aim to finance collaborative research and strengthen scientific collaboration between the Netherlands and Indonesia.

Deadline: 19 November 2024

Perspectiefronde 2024/2025 (open for all disciplines)

NWO Domain AES invites researchers and users (companies, societal organisations) to jointly submit new, challenging research projects within the application-oriented and technical sciences that generate economic and social impact in thematic areas relevant to the Netherlands. For interdisciplinary collaborations.

Deadline: 19 November 2024 (Letter of Intent: 8 October 2024)

Top-up Impact Explorer (open for all disciplines)

A small top-up, for ongoing research-projects in the open competition or talent line, to explore an unforeseen opportunity for impact.

The purpose of this Call for Proposals is to explore opportunities for societal impact arising from curiosity-driven research. These are opportunities and ideas that were not anticipated in advance when the project plan was made, but have emerged during the lifetime of a project. ZonMw Open Competitie 2024 (psychologie)

ZonMw Open Competitie is bedoeld voor excellente onderzoeksteams om hun onderzoekslijnen te innoveren voor wat betreft inhoud én samenwerking. Het oogmerk is ruimte creëren voor team science leidend tot synergistische, grensverleggende wetenschap van uitzonderlijke kwaliteit op het (grens)gebied van fundamenteel onderzoek naar gezondheidszorg en innovatie.

Vroege Opsporing Open Ronde 2024-2025 (psychologie)

Deze subsidieoproep richt zich op de vroege opsporing van ziektes, aandoeningen of risicoindicatoren bij de (ogenschijnlijk) gezonde mens. Dit wordt gedaan door ontwikkeling en optimalisatie van bevolkingsonderzoeken of screenings m.b.t. effectiviteit, kosteneffectiviteit, toegankelijkheid, geïnformeerde keuze, deelname en vermindering van nadelen en risico's.

Impact Explorer Dementie

Het doel van de Impact Explorer Dementie is het verkennen van de maatschappelijke waarde van onverwachte bevindingen in onderzoek naar dementie. Lopende projecten bij ZonMw die onderzoek doen naar dementie komen in aanmerking voor de Impact Explorer Dementie.

Deadline: 3 oktober 2024

Post-COVID: Van risicofactoren en preventie tot diagnostiek en behandeling (psychologie)

Deze oproep richt zich op onderzoeksthema's voortkomend uit de Kennisagenda Post-COVID en uit het Post-COVID programma van ZonMw. Er is onder andere ruimte voor onderzoek naar preventie, risicofactoren, screening, diagnostiek en (medicamenteuze) behandeling van Post-COVID. Ook kunnen er aanvragen worden ingediend voor vervolgonderzoek en zorgevaluatie. Voor alle onderzoeksthema's is het essentieel om rekening te houden met verschillende demografische en klinische patiëntencategorieën.

Deadline: 8 October 2024

NWA-programma 'Seksueel Grensoverschrijdend Gedrag en Seksueel Geweld: naar een effectieve en preventieve aanpak'.

Het programma beoogt bestaande kennis te bundelen en nieuwe kennis te ontwikkelen over wat effectief bijdraagt aan het zo veel mogelijk voorkomen van (on- en offline) seksueel grensoverschrijdend gedrag en seksueel geweld.
