KIC Digital Identities – A Foundation for Trust in the Digital World (open to several disciplines)

This Call for proposals focuses on increasing digital trust with digital identities for individuals, legal entities and objects. We invite researchers to submit initiatives and proposals that they have formulated in partnership with researchers from other relevant disciplines and relevant organisations in society, including businesses. This will involve looking beyond the boundaries of scientific domains (humanities, exact sciences, social sciences).

KIC Demand-driven Research by Consortia - S (open to all disciplines)

Cybersecurity, climate change, circular economy, housing shortage, aging or healthcare: our society faces enormous challenges that call for knowledge and breakthrough innovations. In this call for proposals, funding for impact-driven collaborative research can be applied for.

Deadline: 5 November 2024

Long-term Europe–Africa WEF Nexus (LEAWEF) Multilateral Research Programme (open to several disciplines)

This call for proposals is the first call launched within LEAWEF Programme. It invites broad consortia that cooperate in impact-driven research projects on the Water-Energy-Food (WEF) Nexus, which addresses the interlinkages, synergies, and trade-offs between the management, production and consumption chain of water, energy and food resources.

The deadline for the submission of Partnership request forms (not mandatory), which are to be submitted to NWO, is 4 November 2024.

NWO Talent Programme | Vidi 2024 (open to all disciplines)

Vidi is an instrument within the NWO Talent Programme. The Vidi target group consists of researchers who are in the transition to leadership. They also possess academic qualities that clearly exceed what is usual and demonstrate development of leadership and mentoring qualities. The Vidi grant funds scientifically innovative research and gives researchers the opportunity to establish or expand a research group.

Closing date pre-registration: 5 November 2024

Closing date full application: 8 April 2025

ADM-LAB: Livings Labs for Adaptive Delta Management in Bangladesh (CADS, Political Science, Psychology, CWTS)

The Netherlands and Bangladesh, as densely populated delta countries, are susceptible to the effects of climate change. Effective natural resource management is crucial for inclusive development, prosperity, food security, and climate-resilient infrastructure.

Deadline: 5 November 2024

NWO Merian Fund Cooperation Brazil – The Netherlands Health in Cities 2024 (open to all disciplines)

NWO, through the Merian Fund, and the research council of the state of São Paulo (FAPESP) work together in the Cooperation Brazil (FAPESP) programme to stimulate Brazil-Dutch collaboration in research, by funding joint research by inter- and transdisciplinary teams of Dutch and Brazilian researchers and stakeholders.

Deadline: 12 November 2024

Partnership Water4All – Water for Circular Economy (open to several disciplines)

Full, associate and assistant professors and other researchers with a comparable appointment can submit an application to conduct research on Water related circular economy. This research must be conducted together with European partners.

Driving Urban Transitions Call 2024 (open for several disciplines)

Driving Urban Transitions to a sustainable future (DUT) is a European partnership about urban change in a global context and for a sustainable future. The aim of the partnership is to create attractive, sustainable and economically viable urban areas in which European citizens, communities and their environment thrive. Themes of this call are about the urban energy transition, mobility and circular economy.

Closing date for pre-registration: 14 November 2024

Closing date full application: 24 April 2025

Blue economy: economic activities and healthy ecosystems in oceans (open for several disciplines)

The joint research projects should focus on balancing oceans' multiple uses for creating sustainable blue economies. Consortia of research institutes and practitioner organisations (both public and private) in the Netherlands and in Indonesia can apply for funding. NWO and the Indonesian Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology (KemendikbudRistek) aim to finance collaborative research and strengthen scientific collaboration between the Netherlands and Indonesia.

Deadline: 19 November 2024

Rubicon 2024-3 (open to all disciplines)

Rubicon aims to encourage talented researchers who recently received their PhD to spend some time at research institutes outside of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to further their scientific career.

NWA Loneliness (open to all disciplines)

The Dutch Research Agenda thematic programme "NWA Loneliness" aims to contribute to a better understanding of the causes and nature of loneliness, contribute to the understanding of effective interventions to reduce loneliness, and contribute to the understanding of the possible taboo of loneliness in society.

KIC Sustainable buildings inspired by nature (CADS)

Many existing buildings have to be made sustainable. This offers opportunities to look more closely at what nature has to offer in the terms of materials, processes and inspiration for developing innovative solutions to make buildings climate-proof. This programme aims for an interdisciplinary and integrated approach for a sustainable built environment with attention to circularity, user comfort, health and biodiversity.

KIC Value in Transition(s) (open to all disciplines)

Cities Amidst Climate Change: Enhancing Physical and Social Resilience in Urban Areas (CADS)

The call "Cities Amidst Climate Change" provides funding for Dutch-Chinese consortia to conduct research into improving physical and social resilience in urban areas. Consortia work together to investigate practical measures to address the impact of climate change, with the aim of making cities more resilient to future challenges.

Deadline: 11 March 2025

Open Access Books (open to all disciplines)

Project leaders or co-applicants of awarded NWO research projects can apply for funding of the costs of Open Access publishing of academic books that result from NWO funding.

The NWO invites eminent researchers to nominate German candidates for a Von Humboldt Prize and German researchers to nominate Dutch candidates. The aim is to encourage international collaboration between excellent researchers.

NIAS - one of the institutes of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW) – has made it its mission to provide a physical and intellectual space for advanced research in the humanities and social sciences that is driven by curiosity and cross-discipline collaboration.

Faces of Science (for all disciplines)

Faces of Science communiceren over hun wetenschappelijk onderzoek en hun leven als promovendi aan de hand van blogs, vlogs, artikelen, lezingen, optredens in de media en activiteiten op sociale media. Zij vormen samen het Faces of Science-netwerk en krijgen handvatten en trainingen aangeboden om hun vaardigheden met wetenschapscommunicatie verder te ontwikkelen.

KNAW Early Career Partnerships (for all disciplines)

Postdoctoral researchers at the beginning of their careers can apply for up to EUR 10,000 to organise an interdisciplinary meeting in the Academy's Trippenhuis complex or another location of their choice.

Institute Gak-KNAW Award (for all disciplines)

Talented early-career researchers may apply for a three-year appointment as a post-doc researcher at an Academy institute to conduct research on the labour market and social security in the Netherlands.

Opens in January: NIAS Individual Fellowship (for all disciplines)

NIAS offers individual fellowships to scholars who wish to carry out independent research in the humanities and the social sciences. For five or ten months, scholars are offered time and space to work on their own research project as part of an interdisciplinary community.

ODISSEI (for all disciplines)

ODISSEI (Open Data Infrastructure for Social Science and Economic Innovations) is the national research infrastructure for the social sciences in the Netherlands. ODISSEI brings together researchers with the

necessary data, expertise and resources to conduct ground-breaking research and embrace the computational turn in social enquiry. [Newsletter 25/9/24](#)

ODISSEI SoDa Fellowship (for all disciplines)

ODISSEI SoDa Fellowship is a programme for early-career researchers in any domain of social sciences. During the appointment as a SoDa fellow, scientists work on data-related projects in social sciences.

Deadline submission: 15 November 2024

Open Science Infrastructure (for all disciplines)

This call focuses on the development of digital infrastructures that support open science practices. It covers the entire spectrum of open science and is deliberately broad in scope to be inclusive of the community's diverse digital infrastructure needs.

The deadline for submitting preproposals: 5 November 2024

The deadline for submitting applications: 22 April 2025

Universität Bielefeld: Research in Groups (open to all disciplines)

The funding format "Research in Groups" is open to scholars from all disciplines post-PhD, based in Germany and abroad. They can propose a research project to be conducted with a curated group of (preferably) international colleagues. There are three different group formats with varying time span and funding options.

Deadline: 28 November 2024

Toshiba International Foundation Grants (open to all disciplines)

TIFO supports projects that promote understanding of Japan.

Deadline: November 30 2024

Wenner-Gren Conference and Workshop Grant (CADS)

This grant program supports meetings and events that promote the development of inclusive communities of anthropologists and advance significant and innovative research. Conferences that we support are public events directed at large audiences of anthropologists.

Deadline: 1 December 2024

Spencer Foundation: Research Grants on Education: Small (Education and child studies)

The Small Research Grants on Education Program supports education research projects that will contribute to the improvement of education, broadly conceived, with budgets up to \$50,000 for projects ranging from one to five years. They accept applications three times per year.

Next call opens early October.

Open Science Meetings (open for all disciplines)

Both researchers and research support staff may submit an application for financial support for organising an open science meeting. The aim of this instrument is to allow open science communities to organise meetings on topics of common interest.

Gruber prizes (Psychology)

The Gruber Foundation, in collaboration with Yale University, invites applications for several opportunities such as the neuroscience prize.

Deadline: 15 December 2024

The Branco Weiss Fellowship: Society in Science (open to all disciplines)

The ideal applicant for a Branco Weiss Fellowship leverages the freedom offered by the fellowship to design a surprisingly novel and scientifically rigorous research project. The fellowship addresses junior researchers with a record of outstanding scientific achievement and a passion for venturing into new territory.

Deadline: 15 January 2025

Fritz Thyssen Foundation: Support of Projects (open to all disciplines)

Support of projects by the Fritz Thyssen Foundation focuses on scholars in the humanities, social sciences and biomedicine fields. The planned project should be limited in terms of the subject and time.

APF Esther Katz Rosen Pre College Psychology Grant Program (Educ.& child stud., Psychology)

The Esther Katz Rosen Pre College Psychology Grant Program provides financial support for efforts aimed at improving the quality of education in psychological science and its application in the secondary schools for high ability students. Proposals must focus on supplying education for gifted and talented high school students.

Deadline: 6 March 2025

Gerda Henkel Stiftung PhD Scholarships and programmes (open for several disciplines)

In line with one of the founder's wishes, a special focus of the Gerda Henkel Foundation is support for up-and-coming scholars. Special attention is made when approving grants to enable qualified young researchers of both sexes to conduct scientific work for a limited period of time and in order to improve their academic training. Applications for PhD scholarships are considered throughout the year.
