Thesis

- Obtaining research experience
- Staff members offer thesis projects
- 2 allocation rounds:
 - September
 - February
- Start of actual thesis projects: from October/ March

Allocation timeline:

- Thesis information meeting (early September/February)
- Register for thesis project on Brightspace (deadline on day of information meeting)
- Project descriptions become available (1 day later)
- Time to make enquiries about projects (about 9 days)
- Hand in your top 5 of thesis projects (dealine on BS)
- Project allocation by thesis coordinator

Internship: 4 types

- Obtaining practical work experience
- Clinical Practical Internship (external: 20 EC)
 - 280 hours of diagnostics
 - Basic Accreditation in PsychoDiagnostics
- Internship Psychology (external: 10 EC)
- Internal Practical Internship (internal: 10 EC)
 - Giving science-based advise to school professionals
 - International students have priority
 - May start in first semester (check Brightspace)
- Research Internship (internal: 10 EC)
 - Supervised by researcher in the Developmental and Educational Psychology unit

Finding an internship

- Responsability of the student
- Attend *Internship Information Meeting* (±one month into the programme)
- Read information on Brightspace
- Entry requirements:
 - School-based Prevention & Intervention OR
 - Needs-based Assessment at School
- Duration:
 - 20 EC = 560 hours
 - 10 EC = 280 hours

- Finding an external internship takes time!
 - First vacancies for February appear in October
 - First vacancies for September appear in February

Registring your internship

External internship:

• Send internship contract to internship coordinator for approval

Internal internship:

• Contact the designated coordinator (see Brightspace)

Internship outside of the Netherlands?

• Register in USIS via "Study Abroad" tile, at least 2 weeks before departure
